
Medical Device User Review Service by Medical Professionals: Establishing an Ecosystem (1)

What's It All About?

We at the Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (OCCI) hope to establish an ecosystem in Osaka and the broader Kansai region for medical device development. As part of that ecosystem, we are building a framework <u>with Osaka National Hospital for Japanese companies</u> to have their products rated through "user reviews" by medical professionals. So far, that framework is showing promising results. To enhance and globalize that framework, we hope to (1) offer overseas companies user reviews of their products by Japanese medical professionals, and (2) offer Japanese companies user reviews of their products by overseas medical professionals.

(2) Set up an overseas user rating service for Japanese companies

We are looking into establishing a medical device user review service by overseas medical professionals as part of our support for overseas expansion of Japanese medical device companies. This project is in keeping with the Japanese government's Asia and Africa Health & Wellbeing Initiatives.
